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Dear Parents,

Again, we would like you to know how excited we are about beginning this year of learning with your child. Our new session started on August 10th, and so far so good.

I would also like you to know that we will be working on Thematic Units this school term and this month the theme is "All about Me". We will become familiar with the learning centers in the classroom and learn the daily routine. During the month the children and teacher will get to know each other.

Parents please be mindful that children are only allowed 9 hrs in the center. Breakfast is from 7:30-8:30 a.m.

I want you to know that it is very important for the children to arrive in time in the mornings so that they have the opportunity to start their day together.
